



## Eclipse Bariatric Case History

### Kevin

**Client Information:** 35 year old Kevin is a T4 paraplegic as a result of transverse myelitis. He was denied rehab close to his home as it was thought he was not a rehab candidate due to his weight.

**Key Assessment Findings:** Kevin's weight is 410 pounds. He has good range of motion for seating.

**Goals:** In order to have independent manual mobility inside and outside., Kevin must be able to do a wheelie and go up and down ramps. Kevin also wishes to loose weight.

**Product Parameters:-** Manual chair that has forward center of gravity for his forward center of gravity- Adjustability for weight change

**Product supplied:** An Eclipse 600 was chosen for its forward center of gravity and because it has adjustability for width, depth, height and seat to back angle.

**Outcome measures:** Kevin was able to pop a wheelie and go up and down ramps acheiving independent manual mobility
