Sydney

Client Information:

Sydney is an 81 year old gentleman living in a facility in Toronto. He has had a CVA affecting his left side.

Key Assessment Findings:

A standard manual wheelchair is not working. Sydney slides out of the chair. He is uncomfortable and has tried several different cushions without success. He has good range of motion for sitting. Initially he had trouble with coordination of his hands and feet.

Goals:

- Independent mobility in facility
- Maintain good posture
- Improve comfort
- Independent tilt

Product Parameters:

- Tilt for gravity assisted positioning
- Foot and hand propel in tilt
- Independent tilt-in-space would be a desired option
- Need a cushion that can provide comfort and pressure relief

Product Supplied:

PDG Fuze T20 manual tilt-in-space wheelchair

Outcome Measures:

Sydney's posture improved, he has independent mobility without compromising his posture and he is more comfortable.



With 20 degrees of tilt in a Fuze wheelchair, Noreen is able to be independently mobile and stay up much longer compared with her old wheelchair.

Noreen

Client Information:

Noreen is an elderly lady living in a facility in Vancouver.

Key Assessment Findings:

Noreen was using a standard folding wheelchair. After 10-15 minutes in the chair, Noreen would fall forward.

A tray to assist with positioning is not helping. Noreen has low trunk tone and is unable to propel her chair.

Goals:

- Independent mobility
- Prevent the slumping forward, improve posture

Product Parameters:

- Gravity assisted positioning in a manual tilt-in-space wheelchair
- Access to the wheels

Product Supplied:

Fuze T20

Outcome Measures:

Noreen no longer slumps forward in her wheelchair. She has improved trunk alignment and is now able to propel the chair.
